A lifelong resident of Louisiana, John Young has dedicated the last 20 years of his career working to make Louisiana the best place to live, work, raise a family and visit. Elected Jefferson Parish President in 2010, John took on the task of restoring integrity and trust to the office. He implemented the first-ever Inspector General for Jefferson Parish and made ethics reform a top priority. As an elected leader, he consistently balances budgets, fights to keep taxes low, and increases transparency and accountability in government. By removing

bureaucratic red tape, he attracted thousands of new jobs to Jefferson Parish and bolstered economic development throughout the region. 
