Meet Charles Boustany~ Dr. Charles Boustany is no stranger to Southwest Louisiana. He has represented this region in Congress since 2004 and has been a champion of patient-centered healthcare, tax reform, and sound energy policy. He has emphasized the need for results-oriented leadership and building coalitions around common-sense solutions. He currently serves as the Chairman of the Tax Policy Subcommittee. As Chairman, he is leading the fight to lower taxes, close loopholes, and simplify the burdensome & complicated tax code that is hampering small business

growth. He is also a senior member of the House Ways & Means Committee, and he served on the Subcommittee on Oversight, Human Resources, and Select Revenue Measures. In 2011, he sponsored the Fiscal Responsibility & Retirement Security Act that would have repealed the Patient Protection & Affordable Care Act passing the House but not the Senate. He is a strong supporter of the RWSWLA, worked very hard to secure the local VA hospital and money to keep the Calcasieu Ship Channel dredged. He authored a bill to stop illegal foreign seafood from invading our country. He is a cardiovascular surgeon with several decades of clinical experience. He was raised in Lafayette, graduated ULL in 1978, and LSU School of Medicine in 1982. He began a successful medical practice in 1990 and for 14 years was committed to helping others by providing the highest quality healthcare to his patients & community. He and his wife, the former Bridget Edwards, live in Lafayette. They have two children, Erik, married to the former Caree' Robin, and daughter Ashley.

<u>LRCA</u>	Amendment 1	Administration of government	Requires that the appointment and qualifications for Parish Registrars of Voters be provided by law
LRCA	Amendment 2	Education	Allows postsecondary education boards to establish tuition amounts for their respective institutions without legislative approval
<u>LRCA</u>	Amendment 3	<u>Taxes</u>	Eliminates the practice of using federal income tax payments as a deduction when computing state corporate income tax
LRCA	Amendment 4	<u>Taxes</u>	Allows an unmarried surviving spouses of first responders who died while on active duty to receive certain property tax exemptions
<u>LRCA</u>	Amendment 5	<u>Taxes</u>	Establishes the Revenue Stabilization Trust Fund
LRCA	Amendment 6	State and local government budgets, spending and finance	Allows the government to use up to five percent of the current year balance from certain funds to address projected budget deficits for an upcoming year

Things he would implement if elected:

- Term limits for Congress and Senate.
- Balance the budget.
- Social Security Stability
- Education is a state issue.
- Immigration Reform-Refugee Resettlement-They are coming from 10 countries that persecute Christians and are 99% Muslims.
- Companies are applying for H1B visas to displace American workers with immigrants. Intel Company is an example they laid off 12K American workers, applied for 14K H1B visas and hired 13K STEM immigrants to fill the jobs.
