Speakers:

Our original Speakers, Todd Escoalona & Jeff Stidham cancelled. Karen Drewett, Chair of PEC and Brian LaRocque, School Board Member (Ward 1) came to speak.

Karen Drewett began by stating that PEC would like to work closely with our club this year. Adding that together, we can accomplish more of our common goals. PEC would like to merge their and our club emails so that we can get more involved with each other's clubs. PEC plans to have evening forums two to three times this year. This will be in an effort to increase the community Republican population. They also plan to have something for the Republican Youth in the community to help get these 18 and over registered and voting Republican. Karen Drewett also spoke about the Governor Mike Huckabee fundraiser. The event will be held February 11 @ 7:00 pm in the Buccaneer Room of the Lake Charles Civic Center. Volunteers are needed. PEC will give a seat to each of our members that volunteer for the event. RWSWLA will be allowed to sell raffle tickets for our Gun Raffle. Our Club Banner may also be displayed at the Huckabee event. Mrs. Drewett opened the floor to questions and closed.

Brian La Rocque began by noting that Public education is always a platform in every election because of the large amount of money funded. It appears that Common Core has an agenda to take over Public Education throughout the U.S. No Child Left Behind still has some negative side effects that are still being dealt with. The federal Government has NO authority to tell the states what to do with education. "Race to the Top" was implemented and then quickly retracted. Common Core in his opinion has components that will cause public education to fail. Education is losing teachers faster than ever before. Many early retire because they are just tired of the system. Charter Schools takes our tax money intended for public school system. The original intent for Charter Schools was for failing districts only. Now it has moved to a "For Profit" business. Charter schools get money for each student they have. If the parent/child doesn't meet the expectations of the school, then the child is sent back to the public system, but the money stays with the Charter School. Common Core is a National Standard. State Legislatives have never put into placed the Common Core standards. BESE is the one pushing it. Common Core has federal funds attached to the implantation. Approximately 42 states have adopted Common Core. This may be the reason it was so easily accepted. How BESE operates can only be changed by the State Legislature.

There are some good things happening within the Public Education system. The media should report GOOD news to help with a more positive image instead of only reporting the negative.

Mr. LaRocque opened the floor to questions and closed.
