About Treasurer Kennedy~

John Kennedy was elected without opposition to his 4th term as State Treasurer in 2011. As Treasurer, he oversees the state's \$10.6 billion investment portfolios. He also oversees local and state bond issues and returns millions of dollars in unclaimed property each year.

Prior to his position as Treasurer, Mr. Kennedy served as Secretary of the Department of Revenue, Special Counsel to Governor Roemer and Secretary of Governor Roemer's Cabinet. He was also an attorney and partner in the Baton Rouge and New Orleans law firm of Chaffe McCall.

Mr. Kennedy graduated magna cum laude in political science, philosophy and economics from Vanderbilt, was president of his senior class, and elected to Phi Beta Kappa. He received his law degree from the University of Virginia and his B.C.L. degree from Oxford University in England where he was a First Class Honors graduate.

Mr. Kennedy is an adjunct professor at LSU Law School and is a volunteer substitute teacher for public schools across Louisiana. He resides in Madisonville, Louisiana, with his wife Becky and their son, Preston. They are founding members of the North Cross United Methodist Church.

February meeting

The meeting was called to order by president, Roby Dyer. Janice Areno led us in prayer. Jackie Hebert led the Pledge of Allegiance.

New Business-

Welcome Special Guests: Peggy Buckels, Region 3 VP, Wanda Aizpurua, slated for LFRW Ex. VP, Heidi Martin, slated for LFRW Recording Sec.

Raffle tickets: Our raffle for this year was discussed. Members will pick them up to sell at a later time. Lana Hafner gave an update on "Pillows for Troops".

Guest Speaker - Senator Ronnie Johns began by thanking Dr. Kurth & PEC as well as the Republican Women for the Presidents' Dinner. He thought it was a wonderful event. This session will be a challenge to close our massive \$1.6 billion dollar deficit. He wishes that Washington would adopt the requirement of a balanced budget. He explained that this deficit has occurred. Some of the budget was based on a projection of revenue and one time money. The money was there but those funds are no longer available. Also, the price of oil has dropped and projections were higher than actual cost and revenue. So, they have to balance the budget. How can it be done? There will be no new taxes. There can be an increase in the cigarette tax which is lower than our adjoining states. During this session, there needs to be a hard look at tax credits, rebates and exemptions. \$6.8 billion dollars of legal taxes are exempted each year. The movie tax credit gives away \$300 million each year. Solar tax credit and industrial tax credit are two other high credits each year. Higher Education will be a priority this session, as it has really been hit hard in revenue. At one time, funding for McNeese was at \$42 million a year and now it is at \$17 million. Senator Johns will NOT support a vote that will cut Higher Education. Common Core will be a huge issue in the next session as well. Schools are concerned about requirements and testing but more than anything, they do not want to have to start ALL over again with the next idea.

Senator Johns opened the floor to questions and closed.

President, Roby Dyer gave Senator Johns a plaque to show that pillows were donated to our troops in his honor. Door prizes were given. Meeting was adjourned.
