<u>Meet Billy Nungesser</u> Called the "hardest working man in America" by one national media outlet for his work to protect the citizens he represents, Billy Nungesser has worked tirelessly to defend his community and fight to rescue and restore the Gulf Coast in the wake of the Deep Horizon Oil Spill.

In 2006, Billy Nungesser was elected President of Plaquemines Parish after the devastation of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. Nungesser also focused his efforts on coastal restoration to protect our wetlands and protect communities from storm surges by developing a master plan and bringing federal, state and private resources together to increase

funding. His efforts earned him re-election in 2010 with over 70% of the vote. He was appointed to the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority Planning Commission, and received the Disaster Recovery Contractors Association's Golden Horizon Award. Prior to serving in elected office, Billy Nungesser was a successful small businessman whose innovative idea of converting used shipping containers into modular living quarters improved the living conditions of our state's offshore oil drilling workers.. In 2002, Louisiana Life Magazine named him one of our states "Top CEOs". Billy Nungesser is an active sportsman and member of the NRA who values our state's natural resources. He created the Pointe Celeste Therapeutic Riding Center to enable physically and mentally challenged people to share in the therapeutic benefits of enjoying nature through free horseback rides.

The meeting was called to order by president, Roby Dyer. Opening prayer was said by Janice Areno and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Tina Mosca.

New Business:

The Teen Republican Club from Sam Houston High School gave an overview of the club projects for this year. Their new 2015 officers were introduced. The Teen Republican Club presented the RWSWLA Club with a \$700 check to be used for Pillows for Troops project.

Guest Speaker - Lt. Gov. Jay Dardenne, candidate for Governor.

He began by commending the Teen Republican Club for all of their accomplishments.

As head of the Tourism Department, he did away with a few high paying positions that, in his opinion, were not necessary. Our area has had record setting tourism in the past few years. 22.8 million people spent 11.2 billion dollars last year. For every \$1 spent on tourism, there was \$38 dollars revenue. Tourism is a big business in Louisiana. As Governor, he will continue to focus on tourism dollars.

We are on the cusp of extreme economic development in Louisiana. Because of Governor Jindai's extensive travels out of state, Lt. Governor Dardenne served in the position of Acting Governor for several months in 2014 and nearly all of 2015, so far. In reference to Louisiana's state deficit, he believes that tax credits and exemptions are the first things that should be cut or capped. Cigarette tax increase is also an area to look at. Louisiana has overcome travesties that would knock other less resilient states to their knees. We love our state and continue to rebuild & overcome. Many companies want to come to Louisiana for business. We need a governor that will bring these people together. There are 3 Republican and 1 Democrat candidates for Governor. He wants our vote to help him bring people together and make good things happen for Louisiana. He thanked RWSWLA for all we do.

Lt. Gov. Dardenne opened the floor to questions and closed.
