Dr. Daryl Burckel, CPA, CVA

In the spring of 2017, Dr. Daryl V. Burckel was selected to serve as the seventh president of McNeese State University and brings to the university 31 years of experience in higher education. Dr. Burckel earned both his bachelor's degree in accounting in 1980 and his MBA in 1982 from McNeese and then earned his DBA in accounting from Mississippi State University. He attended McNeese on a football scholarship where he was starting middle linebacker for the Cowboys on two Southland Conference championship teams that played in the Independence Bowl. He was awarded one of four national NCAA-Postgraduate Scholarships that he used to earn his MBA and he is a member of the McNeese Hall of Fame. Since 1992, Dr. Burckel has been a professor of accounting at McNeese and he has served as head of the McNeese Department of Accounting, Finance and Economics. He holds the Arthur Hollins III Endowed Professorship in Accounting. Dr. Burckel is also a certified public accountant and a certified valuation analyst and his areas of expertise include financial analysis and taxation. He has performed extensive con-



sulting work for local and state governmental agencies, small businesses and companies and serves as a member of numerous boards and professional organizations.
