Speaker of the Louisiana House of Representatives (2016-2020)

 ${f T}$ aylor Barras was elected to the Louisiana House of Representatives in 2007, serving New Iberia's District 48, which covers Iberia, Lafayette, and St. Martin Parishes. He was elected Speaker of the House on January 11, 2016. In the Legislature, Speaker Barras has served on the Committee on House and Governmental Affairs, the 'Committee on Municipal, Parochial and Cultural Affairs, the House Ways and Means Committee, the House Executive Committee, the Joint Legislative Committee on Capital Outlay, the Legislative Budgetary Control Council, and the Atchafalaya Basin Program Oversight Committee. In addition, Barras is a member of the Acadiana Delegation, the Louisiana Republican Legislative Delegation and the Louisiana Rural Caucus. Speaker Barras serves on the Board of Directors of the State Legislative Leaders Foundation and is the 2019 incoming National Chairman for the Southern Legislative Conference. A New Iberia native, Barras graduated from New Iberia Senior High School in 1975, and received a Bachelor's degree in accounting from Louisiana State University in 1979. His career in banking spans the last 35 years in South Louisiana with the last 15 years serving as Market President of IBERIABANK's New Iberia market- the position he holds today. In addition to his work with IBERIABANK, the Speaker has been active in Iberia Parish for years through work as Chairman of the Board of the Greater Iberia Chamber of Commerce, Chairman of the Leadership Iberia program, Campaign Chair and Leadership Giving Chair for United Way, Council Chair of The Shadows, Vice President of the Louisiana Sugar Cane Festival and Fair Association, member of the Iberia Cultural Resources Association, Co-chairman of the St. Edwards School Capital Campaign, and member of Catholic High School Capital Campaign Committee. He is also a former member of the Board of Directors for the Council for A Better Louisiana. His honors include 2004 Outstanding Civic Service Award presented by the Greater Iberia Chamber of Commerce, Mr. Iberia, 1992, and Rising Young Business Leader presented by the Times of Acadiana. Speaker Barras is married to Cheryl Lopez Barras. His son Alex and wife Emily are the parents of his first granddaughter, Lainey Claire.


