John Schroder

John, a small business owner, is a native of Jefferson Parish and a graduate of St. Mary Magdalen Catholic School, East Jefferson High School and Southeastern Louisiana University. He served as a U.S. Army CID Special Agent and then worked as a narcotics detective in Ascension Parish. John has been married for 32 years to Ellie Daigle Schroder, a retired schoolteacher & administrator. Bringing his business and entrepreneurial background to Baton Rouge, John was first elected to the Louisiana State Legislature in 2007 and has served on the Appropriations, Joint Budget, House & Governmental Affairs, Veterans Affairs, Homeland Security, Education, Criminal Justice, Civil Law, Governor's Council on Disabilities and House Executive committees. Since his first day in office, John has been an outspoken voice and advocate for fiscal conservatives. As an expert on the state budget, he has become the spokesperson for the Louisiand taxpayer in the State legislature. John is a founder of the House Fiscal Budget Hawks, which is a group of legislators committed to ending wasteful government spending, balancing the budget, and ending the practice of using one-time money on recurring expenses. John has always been a vocal opponent of increasing taxes. He is one of several leaders



pushing for a streamlined budgeting process and an overhaul of the entire tax system for Louisiana. Last year, John authored legislation that created the Task Force on Budget and Tax Reform and the Louisiana Tax Institute. The Institute is tasked with educating the legislature in understanding all aspects of tax legislation. John was recently named Legislator of the Year by the Alliance for Good Government and St. Tammany Alumnus of the Year by Leadership St. Tammany.


